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## Digi Talents - MOLDOVA

- Slovak-Moldovan job mobility and career development programme
- Providing 50 placements for jobs in leading ICT companies in Slovakia
- For **junior and senior ICT professionals**
- For **students and graduates** of ICT fields
- Duration 32 months - July 2021 - February 2024
- Funded by the European Union
- Partners: Technical University of Moldova (TUM)
- Private companies: ESET, Soitron, IBM, ORANGE

## TARGET GROUP IN UKRAINE

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### Target group - WHO CAN APPLY

**ICT professionals - recent graduates of IT faculties in Ukraine**

**GROUP 1: Students that just finished their Bachelor's degree in June/July 2022**

- They will have to apply for a dual Master's degree (VSEM and UA University) for academic year 2022/2023
- In this case, participants would be allowed to work and simultaneously study online at the UA University

## TARGET GROUP IN UKRAINE

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### Target group - WHO CAN APPLY

**ICT professionals - recent graduates of IT faculties in Ukraine**

#### **GROUP 2: Master's students**

- Students of other Master's programmes at UA universities
- They will have to apply for Academic mobility at VSEMS
- They will keep their studies at the UA University (online)



# IMPORTANT CRITERIA FOR APPLYING



## Personal criteria

- Strong **motivation**
- Availability for **12 months**
- Interest to **work and study in Slovakia**

## Professional criteria

- University graduates of ICT fields
- **English language:** level B1 minimum
- **IT skills:** programming and development, network maintenance, statistics, database development

# WHAT CAN BE OFFERED

## TIMEPLAN

- **Implementation period:** 09/2022 – 02/2024
- **30 placements** - Software Developers, Front-end Developers, Java Developers, Software Engineers, other IT specialists
- **Relocation, study and job placement in SVK:** starting from 10/2022
- **Talent Incubator** (post-arrival professional training): starting from 10/2022





## WHY TO PARTICIPATE



### Benefits - Cost-free mobility programme

- **12-month employment** contract with one of the partnering ICT companies in Slovakia
- Health insurance, social insurance, and other benefits provided by the employer
- Monthly gross salary of **1 300 – 2 500 EUR**, based on skills and experience
- Professional **courses** of programming, English and Slovak language after arriving in Slovakia

## WHY TO PARTICIPATE



### Benefits - Cost-free mobility programme

- **Travel costs** to Slovakia covered
- Assistance with relocation, residence formalities, accommodation, cultural orientation
- Availability of legal and administrative support during the entire stay in Slovakia
- Financial support covering living costs during the **first two months** of the stay in the amount of up to **800 EUR/month**

# STARTING SALARIES ON SELECTED IT POSITIONS

**Companies are looking for junior and senior IT professionals with 1-3 years experience**

## **Software Developers and Software Engineers**

- C++ Software Engineers, C#/.Net Software Engineers
- Front-End Developers (JavaScript)
- Java Developers
- Other IT specialists (QA Tester/Analyst, IT Support Analyst, IT Systems Analyst, Data Scientist, Business Analyst)

**Average monthly gross salary 1300 - 2500 EUR**, based on skills and experience

- Final salary level is subjected to of negotiation between the applicant and company



# HOW TO JOIN

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## Selection and matchmaking

1. Review of applications
2. Testing IT and language skills
3. Interview with programme HR team
4. Matchmaking between candidates and IT companies
5. Interviews with IT companies – Final Match
6. Talent Incubator with specialised IT and language trainings
7. Preparing for departure, logistical arrangements and pre-departure orientation
